


**Rose Lane:** Home to undergraduate accommodation and the **T.S. Elliot** Lecture Theatre, which hosts various talks and events throughout the year. You can also use the free **college gym** after an induction session.



**Old Warden's Lodgings (OWL):** Merton's other **library**, just across the road from the main College site. It's open 7.30am to 2am and is another peaceful, comfortable working area. You can find most of your books in here and more can be requested from the Librarians.

**Benefactor's Arch:** here you find the entrance to the college Bar, serving very affordable drinks, and MCR which is home to many of our events.  
Due to renovations, the MCR is currently closed for MT 25.

**Fellows' Garden:** a great space to revise in the summer, with Wi-Fi across the whole lawn and really beautiful views of Christ Church Meadows. You can also relax at the stone table, aka the Tolkien Table.

**Fellows' Quad:** many tutors have their offices here and it's also where our famous annual Time Ceremony takes place.

**Mob Quad:** location of **Mob Library**, a great work space, and the Upper Library, the oldest continuously functioning academic university library in the world. There are also student rooms here.

**Grove:** home to our lovely College Nurse, a part of Merton's Welfare team.

**Front Quad:** where you can find the Porters' Lodge, **Pidge room** (where you get mail), dining **Hall** (Merton's food is renowned for being some of the best at Oxford).

**Chapel:** our wonderful College Choir and Girls' Choir sing services in the Chapel four times a week. Concerts and ceremonies, like the Admissions Ceremony in Freshers' Week, are also held here.
